NOMINATION RULES: Commanding Officers, in consultation with appropriate parties, are requested to submit their nominations in writing, explaining in detail why their nominee should be one of those selected as an Outstanding Public Safety Officer of the Year for Valor, Meritorious or Community Service.

1) **VALOR:** Those public safety officers who have performed an outstanding act in the line of duty, despite the risk of imminent personal harm; or who have been in combat with an armed adversary.

2) **MERITORIOUS SERVICE:** Those public safety officers who have performed an outstanding act in the line of duty.

3) **COMMUNITY SERVICE:** Those public safety officers who have displayed initiative in the creation or application of an innovative, valuable and successful program in the area of community affairs.

All nominations must be received by April 17th, 2017. A 4x6 or 5x7 black and white photograph <u>must</u> accompany each nomination. Color is acceptable, however, be aware that it does not print as well.
